

JUBILEE WALK SOUTH

A full circular walk: 6 miles 3 ½ hrs. Footpaths: WP14A, 14B, 13, HM23, WP29, HM3, HM3, WP26 & WP11A.

An undulating walk on footpath, field and woodland. Good scenic views & bird watching.

Can also be done as two circulars: A: 2 ½ miles 1 ½ hours. 1.1, 1.7, 1.8. B: 3 ½ miles 2 hours. 1.2, to 1.8.

- 1.1 Weston Cross Inn, cross over A 40 up Church Lane. Follow footpath along & through edge of Penyard Park past Birches Barn towards Frogmore, onto lane, keep right and over stile.
- 1.2 Cross over water meadow adjacent to Parkfields. Cross road left up towards Hartshill, continue up along edge of Hartshill Wood continue over stile Hellgay Gate, along edge of copse towards Palmer's Flat. Right down lane, steep path through woods towards Kettle Bottom.
- 1.3 Continue downwards turn right into Kettle Bottom & follow lane past homesteads. Keep to track past brook towards Hope's Ash farm, over cattle grid.
- 1.4 Cross directly over Hope Mansell Rd. up steep field, over style at top into Little Perlieu Wood, climb up very steep embankment by ditch, at top turn left down track towards Bill Mills.
- 1.5 Enter hamlet of Bill Mills follow road past Bill Mill, follow road towards Pontshill. At approx ¾ mile past Parkfields turn immediately left into water meadow, cross over style onto lane.
- 1.6 Cross lane; opposite over stile & proceed over fields, keeping to footpath towards Weston Village. Follow footpath & way marker signs, over stile onto lane (edge of recreation field) cross immediately over & follow path on edge of Field, (back of houses) over stile & cross diagonally over Church Field*.
- 1.7 Turn immediately right & proceed down the Church car park. Turn left at the primary school, (School Lane) & cross over A40 and return to the Weston Cross Inn. *Alternately walk through the churchyard & enter Church Lane down to the Weston Cross Inn.
